Q1: Is it acceptable to apply both as an individual artist and as part of an artist/design team?

Q2: How many of our pieces may we submit?

A2: Per page 4 of the Call to Artists, available at <http://discover.pbcgov.org/fdo/art/Pages/Calls-to-Artists.aspx>, up to three samples of past work can be submitted. Per page 5 of the Call to Artists, artists invited to develop a concept proposal will present only one concept art design to the Finalist Selection Panel.

Q3: Does artist retain copyrights to their original artwork used on boxes?

A3: Yes.

Q4: Is presentation of artwork required? Can you submit via email if out to town?

A4: Per page 4 of the Call to Artists, available at <http://discover.pbcgov.org/fdo/art/Pages/Calls-to-Artists.aspx>, shortlist submittal materials must be mailed or hand delivered. Per page 2 of the Call to Artists in the Budget section, artists invited to present their proposal to the Finalist Selection Panel must present their proposal in person.
