PROJECT DESCRIPTION

PROJECT SCOPE

To provide additional boat trailer parking, demolish outdated structures, reconfigured parking areas to improve connectivity, sidewalk connectivity to both sides of the park underneath the U.S. Hwy 1 bridge, and ADA compliant restroom facilities and pavilion. Project will begin after Labor Day with an expected nine month completion.

PROJECT NEED & PURPOSE

Heavy use over the years has necessitated the redevelopment and expansion of this facility. The project will also provide increased boater access to the Intracoastal Waterway and Atlantic Ocean.


