General Background

- Today the US accounts for 5% of the world's population but has 25% of the world's prisoners
- There were 53,885 arrests in Palm Beach County last year
- 1,200 inmates per year return to PBC from the Department of Corrections
- It costs taxpayers \$18,000 per year to house an inmate at the State level and \$48,910 locally in the jail.
- Returning Juveniles offend at a rate of 50% within one year of release



Why Offender Reentry?

- Increased Public Safety
- Reduced Recidivism Costs
- A Decreased Number of Victims of Crime
- Improved Quality of Life for Palm Beach County

REENTRY TASK FORCE

Chaired by Public Defender, Carey Haughwout, the task force was established in 2008 and developed the Countywide Reentry Strategic Plan. This plan guides Palm Beach County in the development and implementation of a coordinated and comprehensive continuum of care for ex-offenders.

RESTORE

The Sago Palm Reentry Center, located in Pahokee, opened in October 2010 as the second reentry prison in the State of Florida dedicated to preparing inmates for a smooth transition back into society. The Center delivers pre-release services that assist in inmate transition.

BACK TO A FUTURE

Juveniles are recidivating at a higher rate than adults. This critical service provides additional opportunities for youth that are returning from residential facilities in order to make sure they stay out of the system.

COMMUNITY REENTRY

Every inmate returning to PBC from the State DOC receives a letter while incarcerated and is paired with a non-profit agency if interested. Services begin upon release.
