WHEREAS, Boynton Beach XXI, LLP, petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on March 23, 2006 for a Development Order Amendment to add land area, add units and reconfigure the master plan and;

1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
2. ALL PETITIONS Condition 1 Exhibit C of Resolution R-2006-0519 is hereby corrected.
